

Road Atlases and Road Maps!



I drove 6,500 miles in the Western U.S. I found the Rand McNally Motor Carrier's Road Atlas beat the old road atlas I'd been using. It has:

- Maps of Alaska, Hawaii, Canada, and Mexico are included.
- State maps also show city maps for major cities.
- To help locate cities on state maps, there's an 8-page section.
- "Shortcuts" on the U.S. map match routes on State maps.
- The mileage between cities section is 21 pages long.
- Roads in ORANGE meet trucking width and height standards.
- There's a list of toll-free hotel/motel chain phone numbers.
- There's a U.S. map showing Area Codes.

State Highway Maps: When entering another state, get a free copy of the current State Highway Map at a Visitor Information Center. They have greater detail than the state maps in road atlases.



State Road Atlases: Some states have commercially-printed state road atlases, like the Texas one at the top, which have more detail than State Highway maps. County Road Maps have even more detail!

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
